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This striking white, elegant 15th-century château is 2 hours from Charles de Gaulle Airport, Paris.

In excellent condition, set in 16.2 acres (706,790 sq. ft) of parkland with a double moat, working drawbridge, and turreted towers.

DESCRIPTIF

This rare property has only been owned by two families since 1799. It is nestled in a picturesque valley, the Château boasts many stories over the centuries. Today, the Château stands as an exceptional, unique, and well-preserved example of medieval architecture. It is in excellent condition, not requiring any structural work, and it benefits from the status of being a "historic monument," which means that 100% of maintenance costs can be deducted before taxes in France and that also includes the Tax Foncier, which is only €2,652.

Originally, it was completely circular, offering protection from small groups of marauding soldiers. It is encompassed by a double moat, home to large fish and a pair of black swans. Access is via a working drawbridge, as shown in the video for this property. The castle's circular design features an inner courtyard adorned with towers, turrets, and buttresses. The elegant white stone walls are clunch (hard chalk), which was used in Roman times. It lends the castle a timeless and resplendent appearance. Clunch, when first quarried, is wet and can be cut by a saw, but when dried out, becomes a hard, durable material that is difficult to work. The terrace overlooking the moat was created in the 18th century, when the south-facing wall was removed. The only visible remaining defenses are the arrow ports in the north tower and the working drawbridge.

Inside, the ground floor offers an impressive 198m² of living space, including a spacious napoleo
